Level Summary

Quick Summary

“Terra’s Toll” is a single-player level intended as a freestanding quest for the video game *Starfield*, taking place after the Chapter Unearthed of the base game, where players have gained some understanding of Earth's current state. The level combines puzzle-solving, exploration, combat, and investigation. Players set out from New Atlantis to investigate a confidential project that was suddenly halted by Aeternum, gradually uncovering its truth.

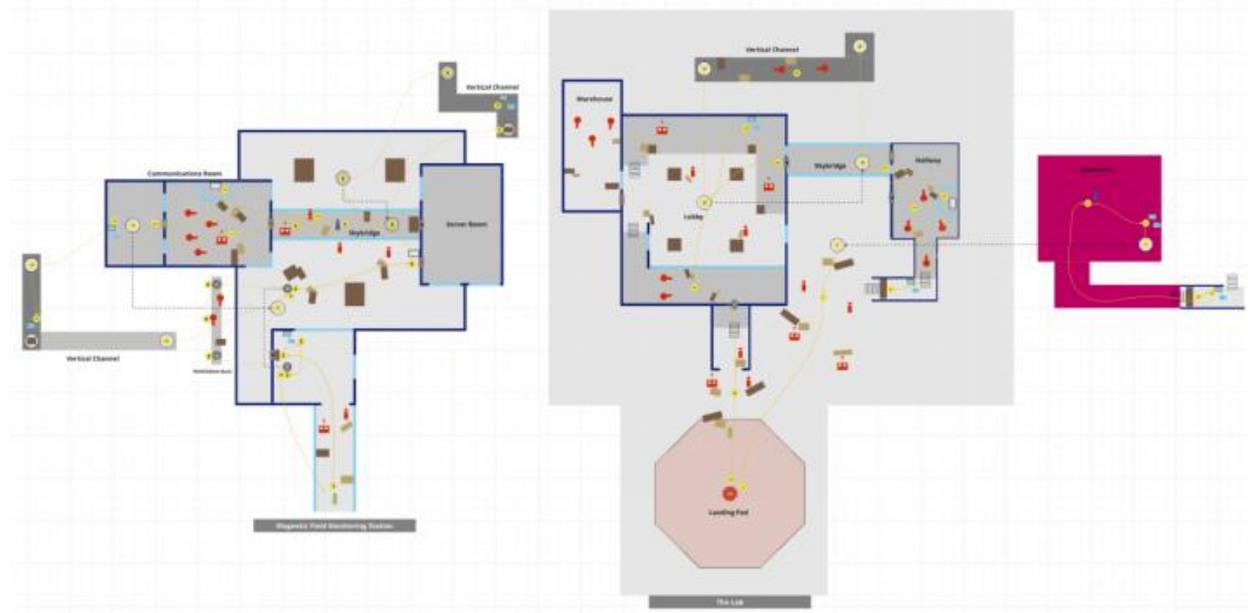

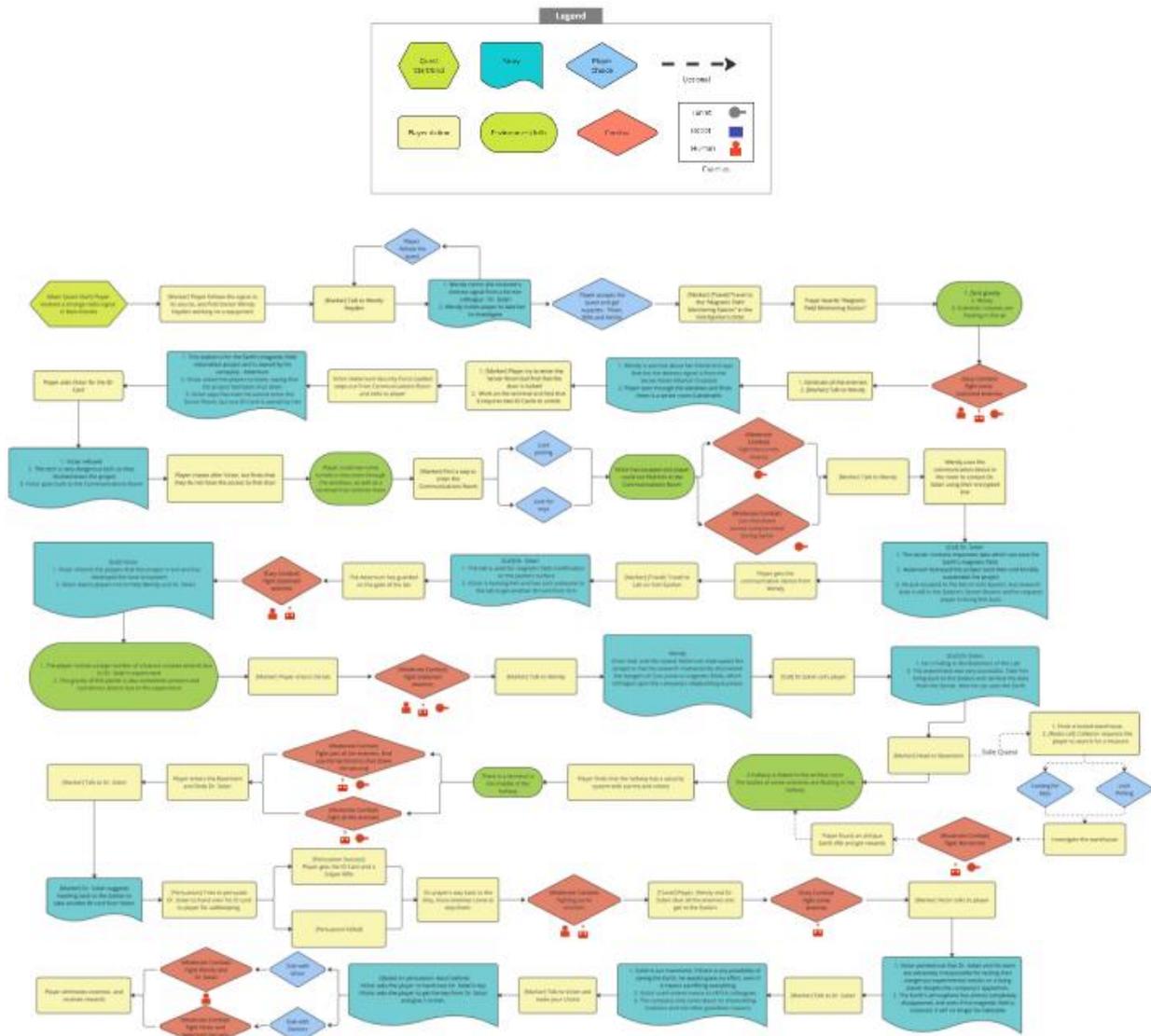


Figure 2: Narrative Flow Summary [2]

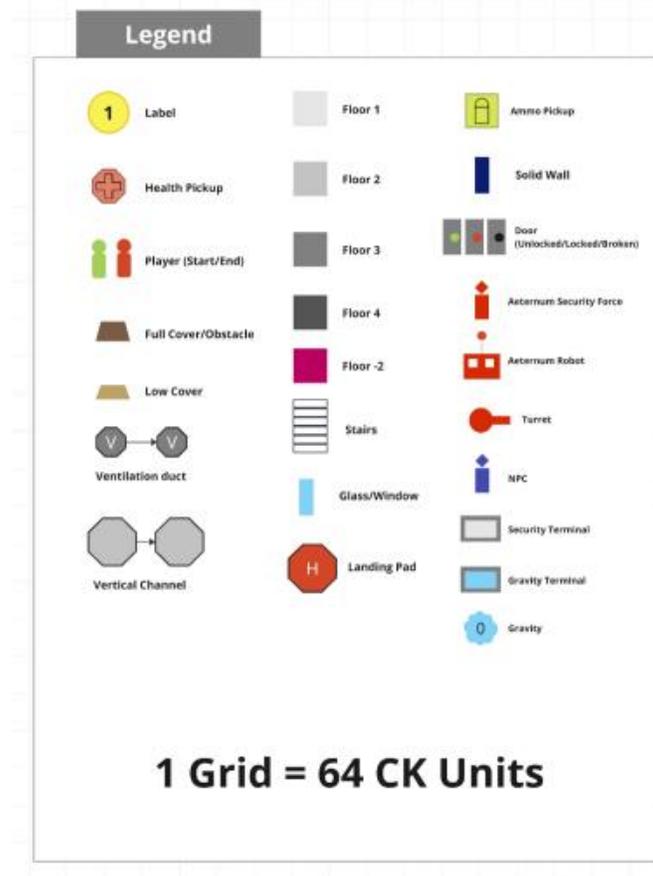


Figure 4: Map Layout Legends [1]

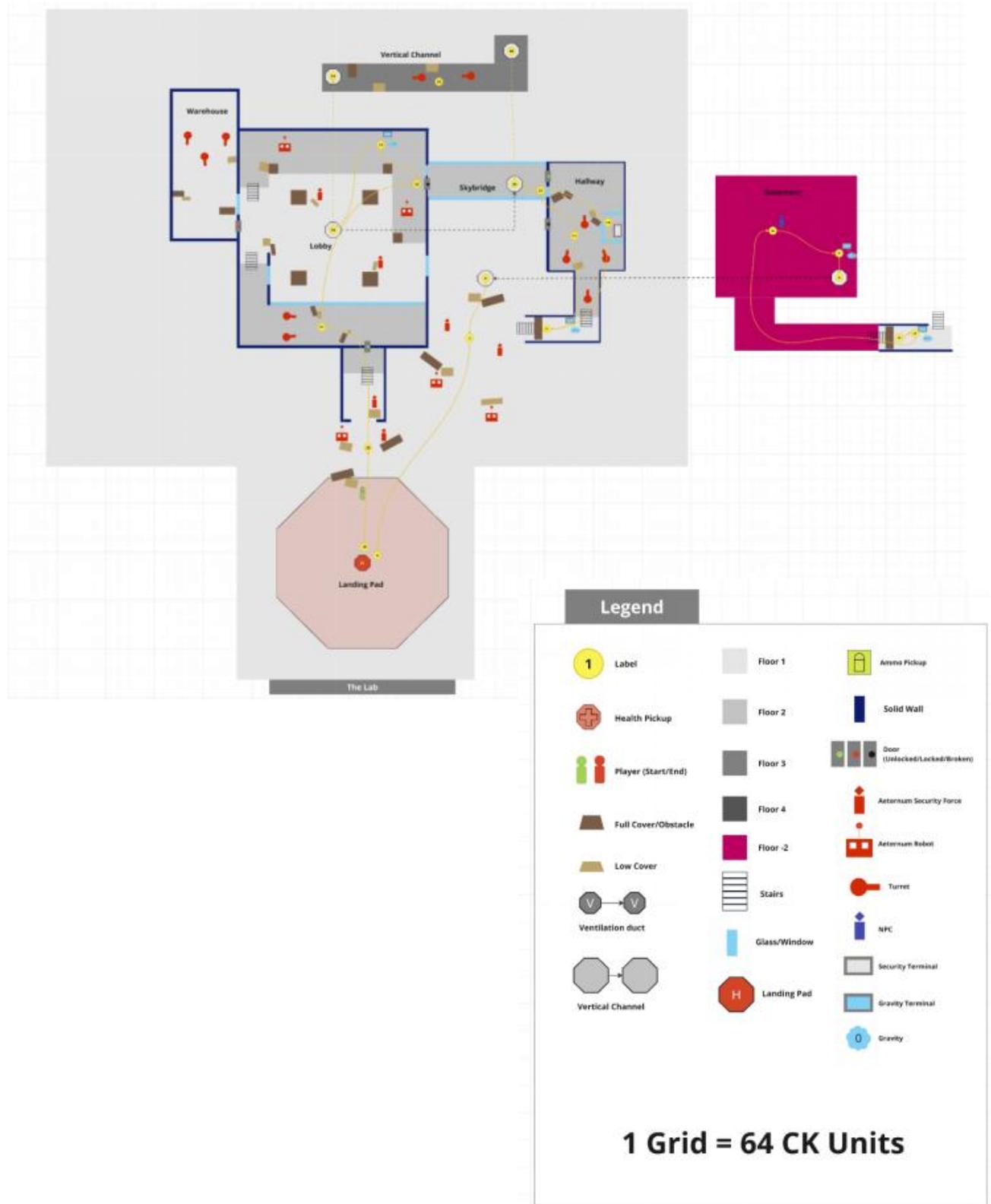


Figure 5: Detailed Map of Lab [1]

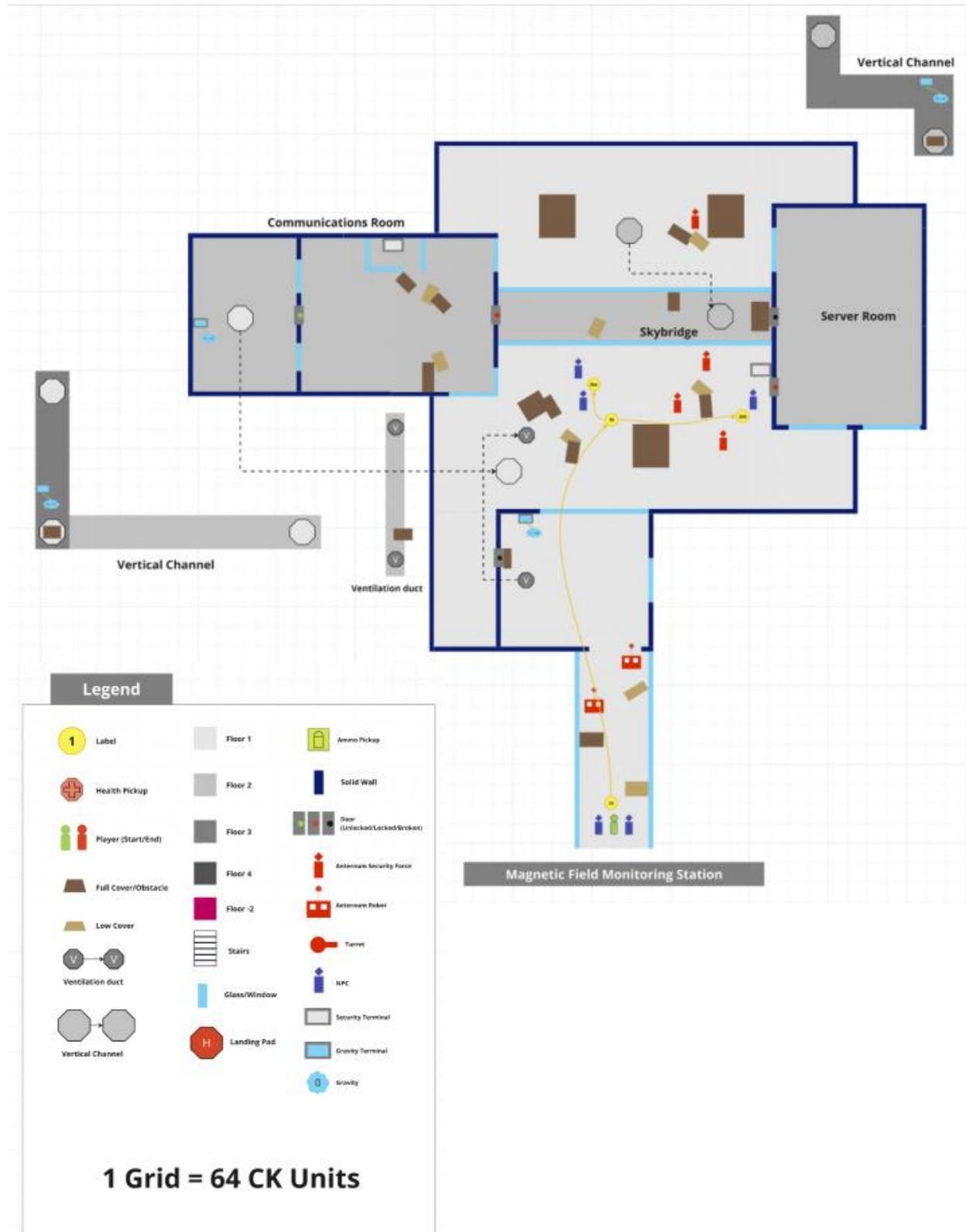


Figure 6: Detailed Map of Station [1]

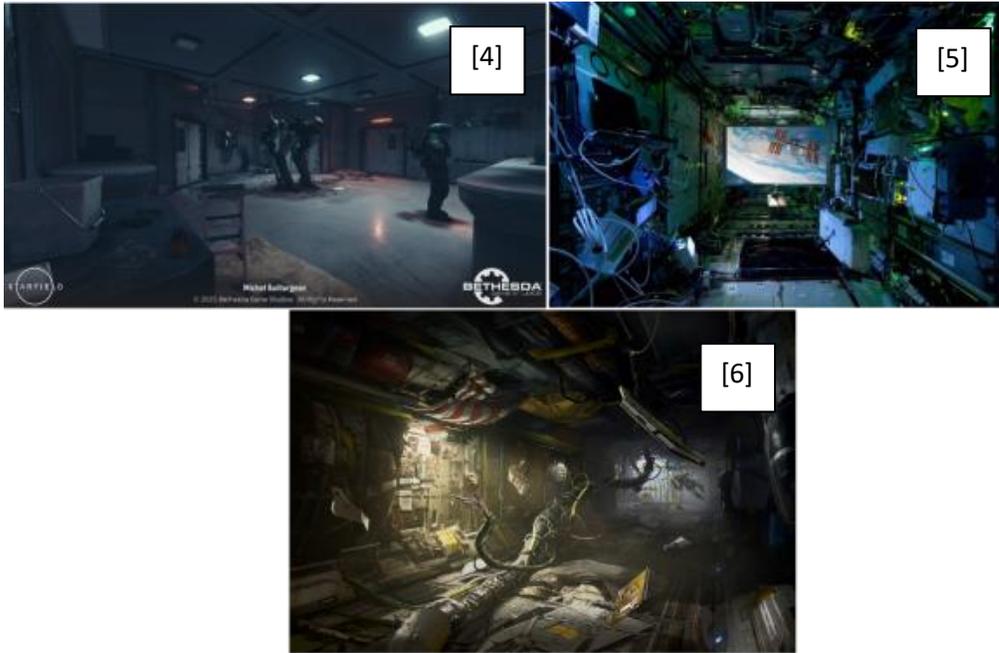


Figure 8: Contact Sheet for Ruined Star Station [4,5,6]

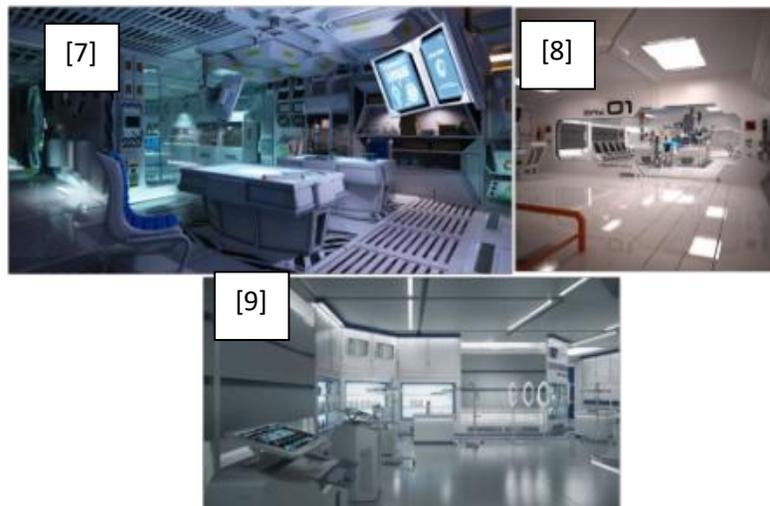


Figure 9: Contact Sheet for Sterile Hypertech [7,8,9]

Appendices

Appendix A: New Skills / Gameplay Mechanics

Adjustable gravity system

Function

The player uses a specific terminal in the scene to toggle gravity between two states (0 and 1)

User Interface

Use the standard Terminal User interface style in *Starfield*

1. Primary Menu
 - a. Title: Gravity Control
Description: Current gravity status ("On" / "Off")
2. Secondary Menu
 - a. Turn Gravity On
 - b. Turn Gravity Off

Numbers

Once the player adjusts settings via the UI, the scene's gravity remains in the chosen state (0 or 1) until the player changes it again.

Feedback

1. Player: With gravity turned off, the player floats and can move in any direction using the jetpack.
2. Weapons: In zero-gravity, firing a ballistic weapon will exert recoil that pushes the player in the opposite direction.
3. Environment: Objects float when gravity is off, and they fall again once gravity is re-enabled.
4. Enemies: Under gravity, they drop to the ground. Without gravity, they will be able to float in midair.

Appendix B: Context Detail

General Context

Aeternum is an ancient technology company whose business includes planetary geological exploration and spaceship manufacturing. Recently, they shut down a secret project on Volii Epsilon.

Backstory

For decades, scientists have been searching for ways to repair the decline of Earth's magnetic field. Aeternum, as a tech giant, has launched a project near Volii Epsilon to study planetary magnetic fields and has reportedly achieved great success. Of course, technology is a double-edged sword; it is said that Aeternum's project conducted large-scale magnetic experiments on the surface of Volii Epsilon, disrupting the planet's natural balance and causing deadly anomalies to local flora and fauna. Now, they have suddenly announced the shutdown of the project, and no one knows why.

Aftermath

Players retrieve the missing scientist, and regarding the research results in the server, people find themselves in a moral dilemma: should they continue to take risks and conduct related experiments, or choose to give up?

If they choose to continue, the number of habitable planets currently known is limited, and the risks of related experiments are significant. However, if the players decide to give up, how can we know that continuing to use Grav Jump technology won't damage the magnetic fields of other planets? Perhaps in the end, these planets will also sacrifice themselves for humanity's journey towards galactic civilization, just like Earth.
